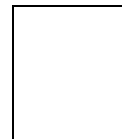
Differentiated Instruction uses assessment and research based teaching techniques to address specific individual needs. This session will provide specific diagnostic instruction techniques to maximise instruction for all levels of students. By using these strategies, instruction can be differentiated to meet each student's unique needs and to recognise diverse levels of expertise and experience.
